## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

No permit will be issued if the proposed party involves the closing of a major street, bus route, hospital emergency route or a street closed for repairs or if other concerns are raised by neighbors, Police Department, or safety concerns.

Upon approval by the Police Department and Alderperson, the applicant must notify the Public Works Department to reserve street barricades (823-7685). The applicant will be responsible for picking up and returning the barricades. Barricades shall be placed in the streets in a manner to prevent the flow of traffic into the permitted area.
